INTRODUCTION

The Coachella Valley Branch of the American Public Works Association (APWA) is part of a national organization who serves professionals in all aspects of public works. Membership within the APWA is not only comprised of personnel from local, county, state, and federal agencies, but also private sector personnel who supply products and services to those professionals. The APWA is dedicated to educating young students about public works and engineering related careers. Public Works is defined as the work of constructing such things as roads, schools, sidewalks, bike trails, reservoirs, etc. that are carried out by the government for the use and enjoyment of the community.

The Coachella Valley branch is pleased to announce the availability of scholarship(s) up to \$5,000 for local graduating high school seniors, who will be pursuing a degree from a four-year college/university with a major in public works, civil engineering, or other qualified related field (see attached list for all qualifying majors*).

BACKGROUND

Each month, members of the APWA gather together to discuss topics and issues of interest among the members. As part of their dedication to the community, members of the Coachella Valley Branch of the APWA are able to participate in events such as monthly raffles, the annual Bob Ross Memorial Golf Tournament, and the biennial Vendor Show in order to help raise money for the scholarship fund. Over the past 18 years, the Coachella Valley Branch of the APWA has awarded 88 scholarships, totaling \$186,000 to date.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college or university for the upcoming academic semester in an approved Public Works related major (Fall 2023)
- Preference will be given to students who attended high school in the Coachella Valley
- Prior APWA scholarship recipients are eligible for scholarship award

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Interested students must submit a completed application form (attached) with all required documents listed below:

- Completed and signed application
- Responses to questions on application 150 words (minimum) to 250 words (maximum) each
- High School Transcripts



AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

After presentation of scholarship (anticipated to be May 1, 2023), and prior to receiving funds, the honored student(s) must submit the following information:

- Proof of registration as a full-time student at a college/university in a Public Works related major (Example: Class Schedule)
- Mailing address and contact information for college/university where funds will be mailed

Once the request for money and the required documents/information is received, scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the Awardees school. Awardees will be responsible for ensuring that all requirements are met.

ANTICIPATED TIMELINE

- Applications are due:
 - Via email* by **5:00 PM, March 22, 2023**—or—
 - Postmarked by **March 20, 2023**
- Applicants will be notified by email by **April 14, 2023**
- Scholarship awardee will be presented with Scholarship award at monthly luncheon on **May 1, 2023**
- Scholarship must be claimed no later than **December 31, 2023**; Money not claimed by this date will be forfeited

* Email is the preferred method of receiving application if possible

Applicants pursuing Public Works related majors not listed above may be considered for a scholarship award based on the merit of the application.
